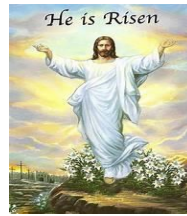

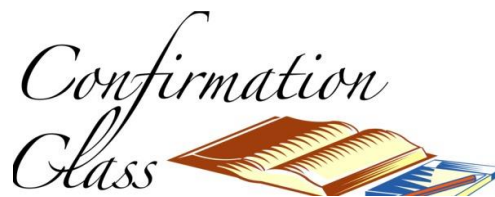




Congratulations and welcome to our RCIA candidates who have now been brought into full communion with the
