Acts 2:14,22-33  
Hear these Words!  
(Acts 2:14)

Have you ever heard the word kerygma? It's a Greek word that means "the proclamation." The Church uses this word to describe the core message that Peter and the apostles preached after Jesus' resurrection. Today's first reading—from Peter's Pentecost sermon—is one clear example of the Church's kerygma, the key events that are at the heart of our faith:

Jesus worked "mighty deeds, wonders, and signs" while he was on the earth (Acts 2:22). The Gospels are filled with stories of Jesus healing people, raising the dead, calming storms, casting our demons. All these miracles showed that Jesus was no ordinary man.

Jesus was "delivered up by the set plan and foreknowledge of God" (Acts 2:23). Jesus' death was not just a travesty of justice or an accident of fate. No, it was part of God's plan. Jesus went to his death willingly, an innocent victim of the sin that was in the world, so that he could deliver us from that sin. "God raised him up" (Acts 2:24). Jesus is now risen from the dead. He broke the chains of death and revealed the promise of resurrection—both for himself and for everyone who comes to him

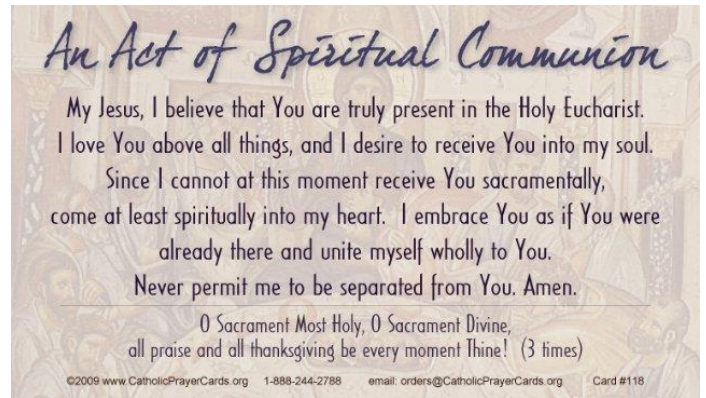
