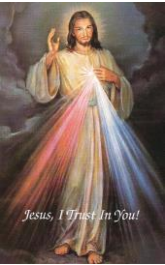

Happy Divine Mercy Sunday! Today we celebrate the forgiveness God extends to us while we are still sinners.

This past week the Diocese sent revised Covid directives. The main change is we are allowed to have one section of pews with every pew open. Thus, in the west section the ropes have been removed and all pews are available for seating. This will allow more people to be seated within the Church and less people will have to be seated in the narthex. Last Sunday at the 8AM Mass the whole Church and Narthex were filled so this will provide few extra spots in the Church.

Additionally while the state lifted the mask mandate the diocese will still require masks at Mass. *"Upon the recommendation of our infectious disease consultants, the mask mandate at public liturgies in the diocese will continue at this time. All congregants (except for infants and toddlers and those who would have trouble breathing) must wear face coverings out of concern for fellow parishioners."* Since Bishop Rhoades is the head shepherd of our Diocese we should be obedient to his directives.

Once again thank you to all who helped make our Paschal Triduum services beautiful and reverent. Don't forget Easter isn't over. We continue to celebrate the Easter season for 50 days until the Solemnity of Pentecost!

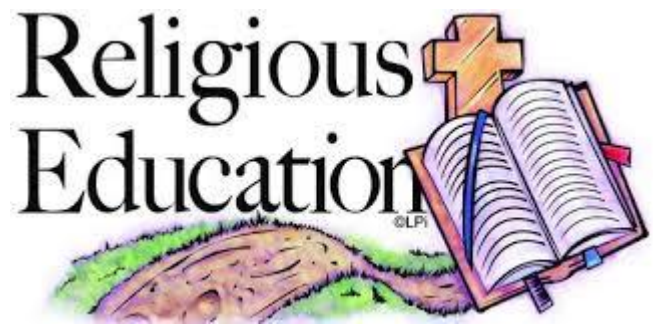
