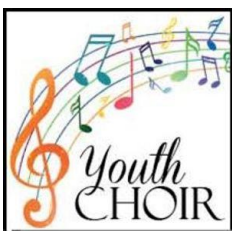
**RELIGIOUS ED REGISTRATION**
