The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) has asked parishes to sprinkle the ashes atop the heads of people instead of making a cross on their forehead. This is the typical way ashes are distributed in Europe. So you will still receive ashes but they will not be visible on your forehead.

One last small change our Friday Adoration will now take place in the Church instead of in the chapel so we can provide ample room for social distancing.
