TOTUS TUUS

A few weeks ago, the Vicar General-Fr. Mark Gurtner met with several pastors from our area to discuss our parish boundaries, since they had not been clearly outlined yet—believe it or not! So, I want to share that Bishop Rhoades has decreed, after consultation with the Presbyteral Council, and in accordance with Canon 515.2 that our Parish boundaries are the following:

North: Noble/Whitley County Line

South: County Road 450 E to Old Trail Road to S 500 E

East: IN 14

West: IN 5 to 400 S to 950 W

We have a parishioner who loves maps and has agreed to create a map of our Parish boundaries for us and post it in a suitable place, with the intention that everyone could be reminded of our responsibility as a community to evangelize and assist our brothers and sisters within this geographical area.

On another note, in line with the continual renewal within our parish, it was brought to my attention that in Columbia City there are usually no school events on Wednesday evenings due to Church events in many Churches, giving many the opportunity to participate of Church events during the week. So, after speaking to our current staff and other parishioners, I thought it made sense to switch the 5 p.m. evening Mass from Thursdays to WEDNESDAYS starting in July. This means that we will begin to have evening Masses on WEDNESDAYS starting on July 6th and on Thursdays, we will celebrate Mass at 8 a.m. Of course, we will have Eucharistic Adoration and Confessions an hour before Mass (So on Wednesdays this will be at 4 p.m.). Hopefully we can promote it among the younger and older parishioners so that we may have an opportunity to stop in the middle of the week and spiritually refuel.

I also intend to celebrate a Mass in the future (date to be determined) on Monday mornings before I leave for a day-off and I would like to ask your input for a time that would be suitable for a Saturday morning Mass. The reason for this additional Mass on Saturday mornings is for those who are going elsewhere for Mass and to allow us to celebrate the special feasts/solemnities that fall on Saturdays. (Please let me or a parish council member know your time preference). In the future, I also intend to resume celebrating Mass once a month at the Oaks Nursing Home, reconnecting us with those who are elderly and sick. Many blessings to all!

Totus Tuus is a summer catechetical program that focuses on Prayer and the Our Father. It is distinctly and passionately Catholic. Children will be involved in various activities with the purpose of guiding them to grow in their faith. During the week, there will be time for adoration, confession and daily Mass. This will replace our summer Vacation Bible School program.
