Due to the annual priest retreat at Potawatomi on June 21-25, there will be no daily Masses at St. Paul of the Cross this coming week.

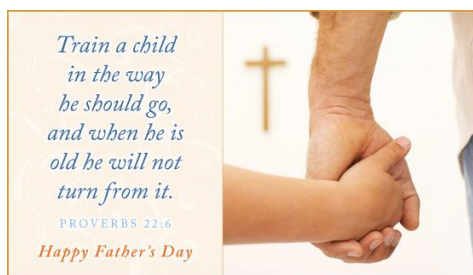
There will also be no Adoration on **Friday, June 25<sup>th</sup>**.
