Next weekend (March 20, 21) will have another Sacrament of Confession Marathon similar to one in Advent.

Confession times will be:

- Saturday, March 20. 3:45-4:45, and after 5PM Mass until the last person has gone.
- Sunday, March 20. 7:30-7:45, between the 8 and 10:30 Mass, between the 10:30 and noon Mass, and after the noon Mass until the last person has gone.

Did you know our parish has a Facebook group? On Facebook search "St. Paul of the Cross Columbia City". Request to join, and then one of the admins will accept your request.

I've finalized the schedule for the second round of recollection and training/retraining for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC), Lectors, and Ushers. All current and those interested in becoming EMHC and Lectors *must attend both* a time of recollection and a training/retraining session. All current and those interested in ushering only need to attend the training/retraining. If you want to remain on the schedule beginning June and onward attendance of both events is necessary. - Sunday, April 11th between 8-10:30 Masses, beginning at 9:05AM
- Tuesday, April 13th at 6PM

Retraining/training for EMHC. Will last about an hour.

- Saturday, April 17th after 5PM Mass
- Sunday, April 18th between 8-10:30 Mass, beginning at 9:05AM

Retraining/training for Lectors. Will last about 30 minutes

- Saturday, April 24th after 5PM Mass
- Sunday, April 25th between 8-10:30 Mass, beginning at 9:05

Retraining/training for Ushers. Will last about 30 minutes.

- Saturday, May 1st after 5PM Mass
- Sunday, May 2nd between 8-10:30 Mass, beginning at 9:05.
