I've finalized the schedule for the second round of recollection and training/retraining for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC), Lectors, and Ushers. Retraining/training for Ushers. Will last about 30 minutes.

- Saturday, May 1st after 5PM Mass
- Sunday, May 2nd between 8-10:30 Mass, beginning at 9:05.
