Bishop Kevin C. Rhoades has announced that the general dispensation from the Sunday obligation will expire on June 11. Because the Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian Life, all Catholics are required to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation unless a serious obstacle prevents them. As mentioned the past couple weeks in the bulletin, this Sunday is our last noon Mass.

Some exciting news, because of recent security upgrades, our chapel will now be open later in the evenings for prayer. Beginning June 7 the chapel entrance (the southeast door facing Spencer St.) will be open as follows:

- Monday-Thursday: 7AM-9PM
- Friday: 7AM-7PM
- Saturday: 3:30PM-9PM
- Sunday: 7AM-Noon

If anyone would like to volunteer to help unlock or lock, especially days when I might be out of town, please email me at frdavid@saintpaulcc.org. It's been a desire since I arrived to have the chapel more available for prayer.

On Tuesday, June 1st there will be no 7:30-7:45 Confession or 8:00 AM Mass. The office will also be closed. I am going to spend an extra day after Memorial Day with my family.

Next Sunday after the 10:30 Mass we will have our Corpus Christi procession. Some logistics:

- Incense will be used extensively during the 10:30 Mass, so if you are sensitive to it, please consider attending either the 5PM or 8AM Mass
- After Communion I'll do the Prayer After Communion and then the Procession will begin. There will be no final blessing.
- If you are not participating in the procession, please stay in the Church and allow the procession to leave. We don't want to have to battle the parking lot.

- We will walk down Ellsworth Street to the Catholic section in Greenhill Cemetery. There is an Altar in our section.
- While walking to the cemetery we will walk in the street and during the procession we will have parishioners leading prayers.
- Once at the cemetery we will have 10 minutes of silent adoration followed by Solemn Benediction.
- After Benediction there will be no formal procession back. You can make your way back to the Church at your own pace. Please use the sidewalks to come back to the Church.
- This is our first year doing a procession like this, so we'll see how it works!
