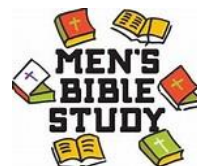

MEN'S BIBLE STUDY

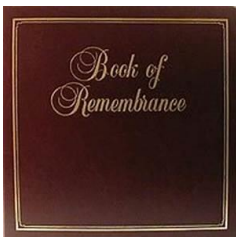


The Men's Bible Study group will be meeting in the Sofa Room at 6pm this coming Sunday. All men of the parish are always invited to join in.
