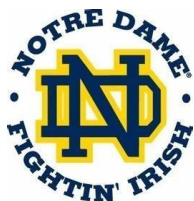
Thank you for your generosity towards Sister Nancy's mission appeal. She enjoyed her visit and meeting the families of our parish.
