If you donated at our last drive in September, you are eligible to donate again. Please don't think because you donated once that that is enough. The need for blood is constant. Nationally the Red Cross is short 80,000 units at this time. Critically ill patients **DEPEND** on people who regularly donate blood every eight weeks.

Walk-ins are welcome, but please sign up ahead of time to avoid waiting. Blood donors can sign up online at [redcross.org](http://redcross.org) or a signup sheet posted in the church Narthex, but please **do not sign up at both places**. Hope to see you on Nov 3<sup>rd</sup>. Reminder to all, that daylight savings time ends Saturday night (Nov. 2), so please turn clocks back 1 hour before going to bed Saturday evening.

Donors are asked to bring an ID with them and to also eat and drink fluids before their donation time. Thanks in advance for your donation!

## Third Annual Pajama Sewing:



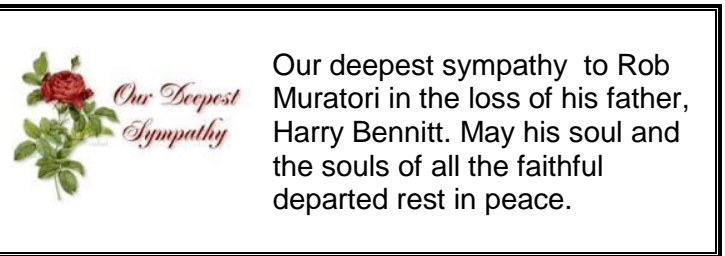
Mondays Nov 11th and Nov 18th at 6:30 pm in the Joe Zickgraf Community Hall
